**The Need:** Elsie Allen High School has 1,030 students, 73.1% of whom come from socio-economic disadvantaged families and 82% are Latinx. The majority of our students are the first from their families to graduate from high school and will be the first from their families to attend and graduate from college. Elsie Allen is located in southwest Santa Rosa which has been historically underserved. Many of our students come from families who:

- have a household income of less than \$50,000 a year;
- do not have access to quality healthcare;
- do not have resources to support their children's post-secondary educational journey.
